Directions to El Camino Hospital in Mt. View

Directions from San Francisco:

Via 101 South to 85 South:

Exit at Grant Road/El Camino Real North
Cross El Camino Real – Hospital 1 mile on right

Via Hwy 280 South to Magdalena Exit:

Turn left onto Magdalena at Stop Sign
Right on Foothill Expressway
Left on Grant road – Hospital 2 miles on left

Directions from East Bay:

Via Hwy 84 West across Dumbarton Bridge:

Turn on Willow Road and Take Hwy 101 S
Take 85 S to Grant Road/El Camino Real North
Cross El Camino Real – Hospital 1 mile on right

Via Hwy 880 South to Hwy 237 West:

237 becomes Grant Rd
Cross El Camino Real – Hospital 1 mile on right

Directions from San Jose:

Via 101 North to Hwy 237 West:

237 becomes Grant Rd
Cross El Camino Real – Hospital 1 mile on right

Via Hwy 280 North to Foothill Exit:

Right on Foothill Expressway
Right on Grant road – Hospital 2 miles on left
